

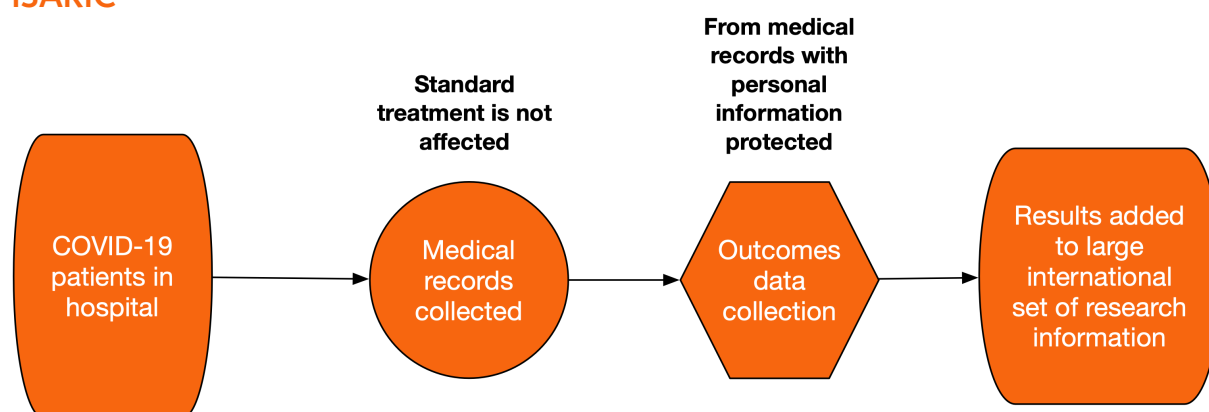


Study Summary

ISARIC is an international group of clinical research networks. Together they are collecting information from a variety of studies on outbreaks of infectious disease. Their aim is to coordinate rapid response to new diseases like COVID-19. For this new disease ISARIC is collecting information from a large number of study centres and from various studies. Some of those studies (Levels 1 and upward) involve taking samples and conducting tests on patients. At Barts Health (Level 0) only patients' medical information is being shared with ISARIC for analysis and comparison with information from other studies elsewhere:

The aim of ISARIC is to find the best way to treat patients with COVID-19 and other new infectious diseases in the future by building up a large 'ISARIC COVID-19 database'. This will provide researchers with as much accurate information as possible in discovering more about COVID-19.

There is no 'intervention' or change in the normal treatment for patients in this Level 0 study, just a collection of their medical records. Personal information is protected in all the information collected.
